

As you may be aware, the world of Data Protection changes on 25 May 2018, with the introduction of General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR). This means that the way in which organisations handle the data of its own people and external contacts changes.

As a school, the vast majority of data we hold on our students and their parents or guardians is required for either legal reasons, or in the vital interests of your child, or in the public interest in our role as a school.

Notwithstanding that, and acting in line with the current DFE guidelines, we have created a new Privacy Notice for students, parents, guardians and carers. This forms the basis of the way in which we handle data within our Trust.
