## SCHOOL DINNERS

Students will be able to purchase a school dinner. It is important that you top up your child's account via the parent pay app.

Please be aware that food / drink purchased at school during break and lunch needs to be ordered via Forms. Your son / daughter will receive an email by 6.30pm in an evening and it needs to be completed and returned by 8.30am the following day to ensure their requests can be catered for. Students will not be able to select their food at the canteen or the Pod.

## **TRANSPORT TO SCHOOL**

In line with the government guidance, we would encourage students to walk or cycle to school where possible. However, we are aware that we have many students outside of the catchment area and they will need to use transport. We ask that they follow the rules regarding face coverings and sanitising hands.
