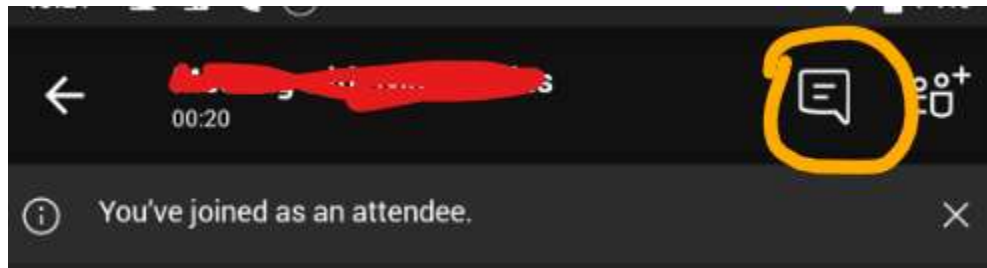

TEAMS INFORMATION

We believe a few students have been struggling to access the chat in the live learning sessions when using a mobile device, so we are hoping the following information will help:

If the student touches the screen, it should bring a banner at the top with the class name on, and on the right-hand side they should be able to press the “chat” button like so:



Once they press this, they can go into the chat – however due to screen size limitations it means it switches their camera off and they may not be able to see what is being shared.

Obviously, the preferred approach is for students to use a laptop, rather than a mobile phone as the phone not only causes more issues in terms of eye strain, but also results in not being able to access all class materials that are shared. If you require a laptop, please get in touch, initially through your son's / daughter's House Leader.
